Fabien Cousteau

Grandson of Jacques Cousteau, one of the world's greatest underwater explorers

I started scuba diving on my fourth birthday. I remember that a family friend took me to the bottom of the pool and taught me breathing exercises and other diving skills. I was very young to start diving but I come from a family of divers and it seemed quite normal. Not long after, I was given some specially-made diving equipment and started diving off the coast of California. But the diving that stays in my mind was on a trip to Papua New Guinea with my family when I was seven. We were there for five weeks and it was amazing.

Today, the amount of diving I do depends on the project I'm working on. For example, a recent television programme I made with my father, called *Underwater Treasures*, included 342 dives at 13 different locations in the USA. We had a certain number of weeks to make the programme and the locations where we wanted to film were so far apart that we had to fly everywhere. I think a lot about the damage to the environment caused by so much air travel and generally prefer to sail to a dive, but it simply wasn't possible this time.

Another recent project with a lot of diving was the book *Ocean*. It is a wonderful celebration of life on the water planet. It covers everything about the world's oceans with information on approximately 450 species (from whales to jellyfish) and over 1300 fantastic pictures. It also looks at the effect of global warming on the oceans, and other environmental issues. I prefer not to call *Ocean* an 'encyclopaedia' because it's more interesting than that word suggests, and people might get the wrong idea. Working on the book certainly taught me a lot.
