

1. A continuous action at a certain moment in the past.

An action in progress which began before a certain moment in the past and continued up to a certain period of time in the past.

They were tired as they had been walking

for a long time already. She put aside the book which she had been

### Past simple

- an action that happened at a definite time in the past Last year we bought a dog.
- actions that happened immediately one after the other in the past

Lou took a shower, brushed his teeth and went to bed.

### Past continuous

- an action that was in progress at a stated time in the past Yesterday at 4 I was talking to Meg on the phone.
- two actions that were happening at the same time Liz was vacuuming while her sons were tidying their room.
- an action that was in progress (longer action) when another action interrupted it

### past perfect

- an action that happened before another action in the past Before we left, we had booked a hotel room.
- complete past action that had visible results in the past We felt relieved after they had arrived safely.
