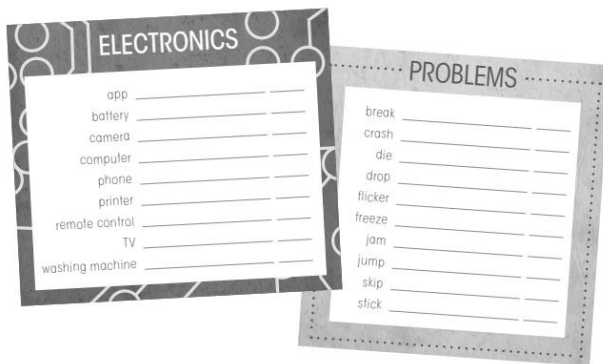

Printer	Device that is connected to an electronic computer and that serves to print the selected information contained in it.	The printer is out of ink.
Remote control	Is an electronic device used to perform remote or remote operation on a machine.	You can change the batteries to the remote control please.

TV	An electronic device intended for the reception and playback of television signals.	The TV channels are very entertaining.
Washing machine	It is an appliance that serves to wash clothes.	My mom broke the washing machine.
Break	It's when you break something.	The screen of my phone is break.
Crash	That's when you have a car accident.	The glass of my laptop is crash.
Die	When someone loses their life.	I run out of battery. My phone died!
Drop	Make something or someone stop being roasted, tied, or held.	Drop the cell phone, it's mine.
Flicker	Flashing flashes, a light or losing and gaining intensity in fast, alternating sequences.	My cell phone screen flicker when charging.
Freeze	When the screen of a device gets stuck out of nowhere and it takes time to work again.	My tablet screen freeze because it is overheating.
Jam	Difficulty that prevents or delays accomplishing something.	My phone jam when I use multiple apps at the same time.
jump	Detach or break from something that was fixed.	The printer jump caused a lot of blank sheets to come out.
Skip	Go from one thing to another without following the order.	You must skip code.
Stick	Stick or bond resistively to something.	The screen glass stick to the phone very quickly.
