

Jump	Unattended access refers to accessing remote systems without requiring interaction from a remote user to initiate the access.	My radio keeps jumping my favorite songs.			
Skip	To move	My computer keeps skipping the important things.			
Drop	To let something you are carrying fall to the ground	She dropped the computer in the hole.			
Camera	A piece of equipment used to take photographs or to make films	They've installed a security camera.			
Computer	An electronic machine that can store and arrange large amounts of information	Make sure you switch your computer off.			
Phone	A communication system that is used to talk to someone who is in another place	The phone lines have been jammed since the concert was announced.			
Printer	A machine that is connected to a computer and that produces writing or images on paper	I need to buy a new printer, mine stop working yesterday.			
Remote control	A piece of equipment that is used to control something such as a television from a distance	My little cousin lost my grandmother's Tv remote control.			
TV	A piece of equipment, with a screen on the front, used for watching tv shows	My households own more than one television.			
Washing machine	A machine that washes clothes	I use daily my washing machine, so my clothes can be clean.
