The more you appreciate and understand the <b>art</b> of different eras, movements, styles and techniques, the better you can develop, evaluate and improve your own artwork.	Intelligence	the ability to learn, understand, and make judgments or have opinions that are based on reason
Communication skills	<b>Communication skills</b> are the abilities you use when giving and receiving different kinds of information. Some examples include <b>communicating</b> new ideas, feelings or even an update on your project. <b>Communication skills</b> involve listening, <b>speaking</b> , observing and empathising.	Leadership	the set of characteristics that make a good leader
