I'm from Mexico.

You're from Brazil.

He's from Japan.

She's a business student.

It's an exciting city.

We're in the same class.

They're my classmates.

Contractions of *be*

I'm = I am

you're = you are

he's = he is

she's = she is

it's = it is

we're = we are

they're = they are

They're really nice.

5. A: Are you Marey and Yuka classmates?

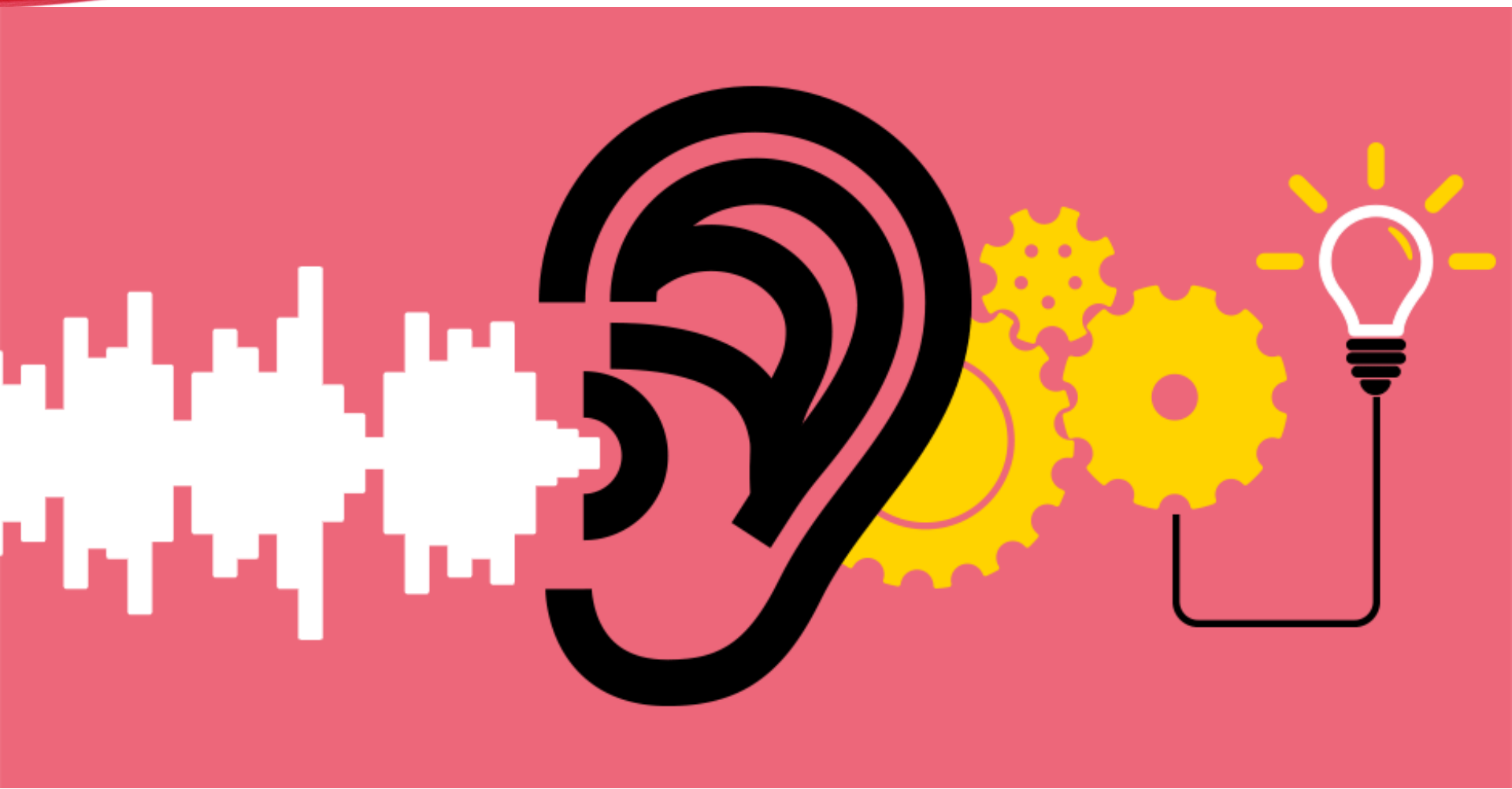
B: Yes, Mary and Yuka are in my class.
