You're from Brazil.

He's from Japan.

She's a business student.

It's an exciting city.

We're in the same class.

They're my classmates.

### Contractions of *be*

I'm = I am

you're = you are

he's = he is

she's = she is

it's = it is

we're = we are

they're = they are

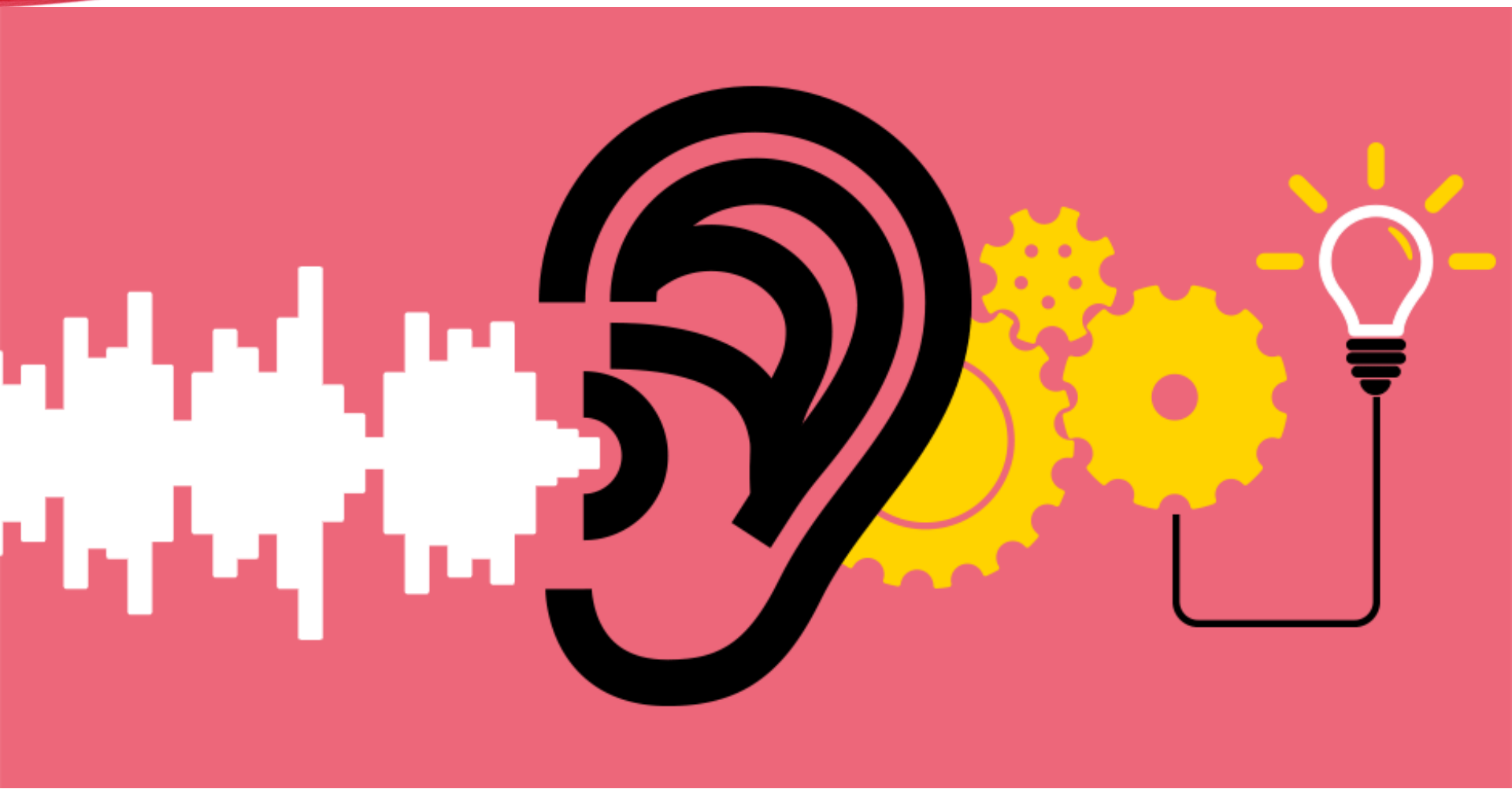
