GRAMMAR "Words in plural"

A plural noun is a word that indicates that there is more than one person, animal place or thing. When you write about more than one of anything, you usually use the same word, adding **s, es,** or **ies** to the end.



Some nouns are always plural

Ends in VOWEL + Y

add -S

1 day 2 day**s** 1 key 2 key**s**

Ends in CONSONANT + O

add -ES

1 tomato 2 tomatoes

1 potato 2 potatoes

Exceptions: piano - piano s

photo-photos

Ends in F or FE

remove F/FE add -VES

1 life 2 lives 1 knife 2 knives
