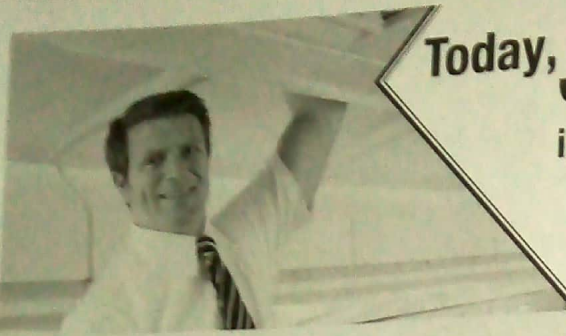

Job Talk: And what do you like best about your job?

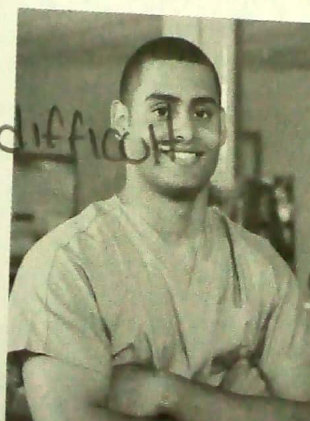
