## Lesson 3 Possessive Adjectives

- ✓ We use possessive adjectives to express who owns (or 'possesses') something.
- ✓ A possessive adjective is used in front of a noun (a thing).
- ✓ For example: **My** computer, **Your** pen, **his** name, **her** nickname



**My** cap is red



**Your** cap is orange



**Her** cap is red



**His** cap is red



**Their** caps are red



**Our** caps are nice
