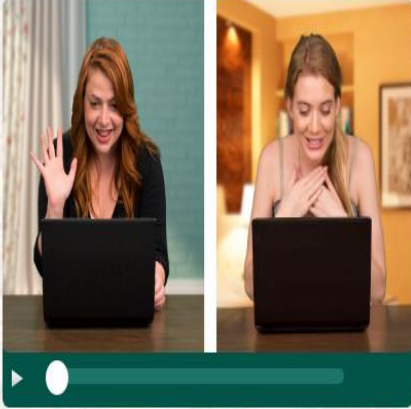

The Present Continuous

You use the Present Continuous tense to **ask** and **say** what you are doing now.
You often use time markers like *now*, *at the moment*, *today* or *this week* with the Present Continuous tense.
Questions can start with **How/Wh-words**. Remember you use Wh-questions to get information about places, people and things. You ask Wh-questions often when you travel.

Questions	Statements
How's it going?	I'm melting at the moment.
What are you doing today?	I am learning about Mexican food today.
Where are we going?	We are going sightseeing now.
