




Ex. There is a post office  $\underline{next to}$  the hotel on  $3^{rd}$  street.

Imagine you are new in town and you're not familiar with the neighborhood, write 10 QUESTIONS to ask about the neighborhood shown in the picture below. Write the answer to each question. Check the examples.



Ex.

*Is there a department store near here?* Yes, there is. There is one <u>on the corner of</u> Oak and  $2^{nd}$  Street.

**Are there any shops in the neighborhood?** Yes, there are. There are some shops <u>in front of</u> the drugstore.
