1° Are there hospitals near here? Yes, there is one on the corner of one street.

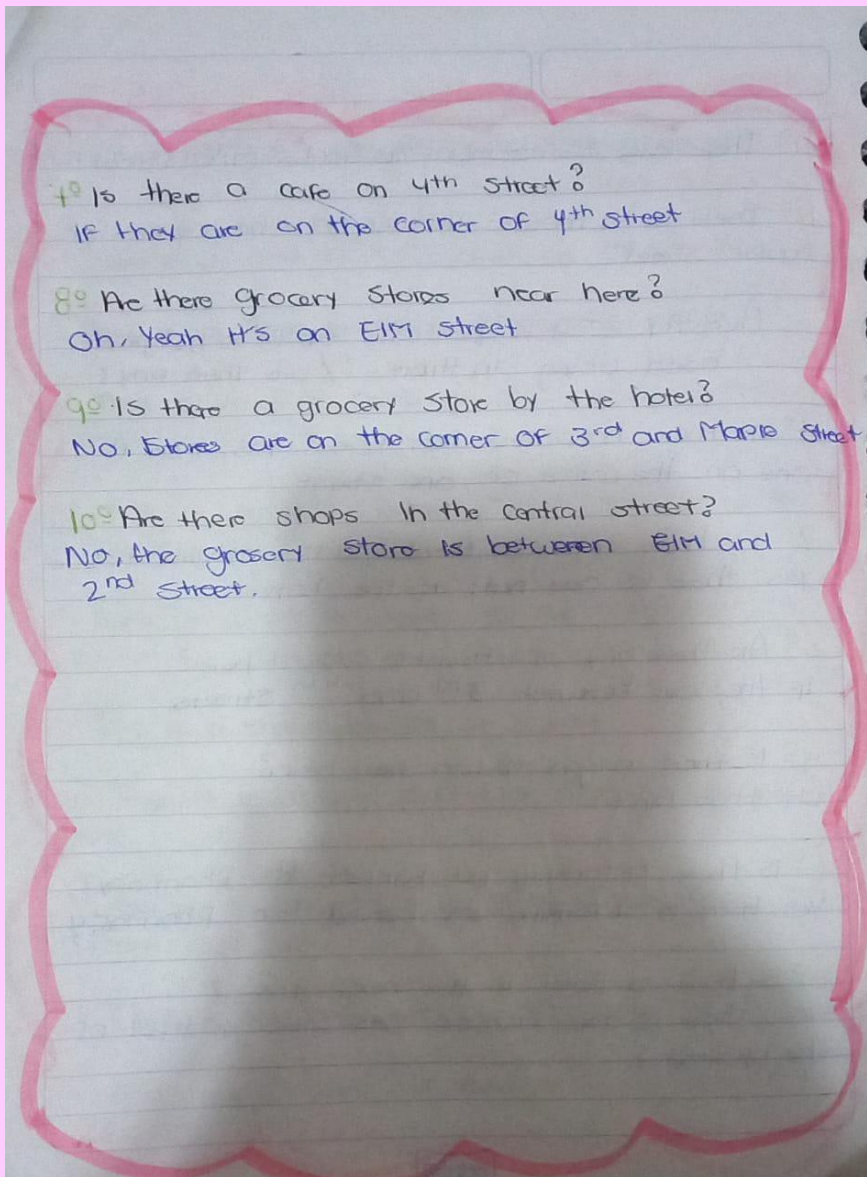
2° Is there a movie theater in the neighborhood? Yes, there is one next to the hotel.

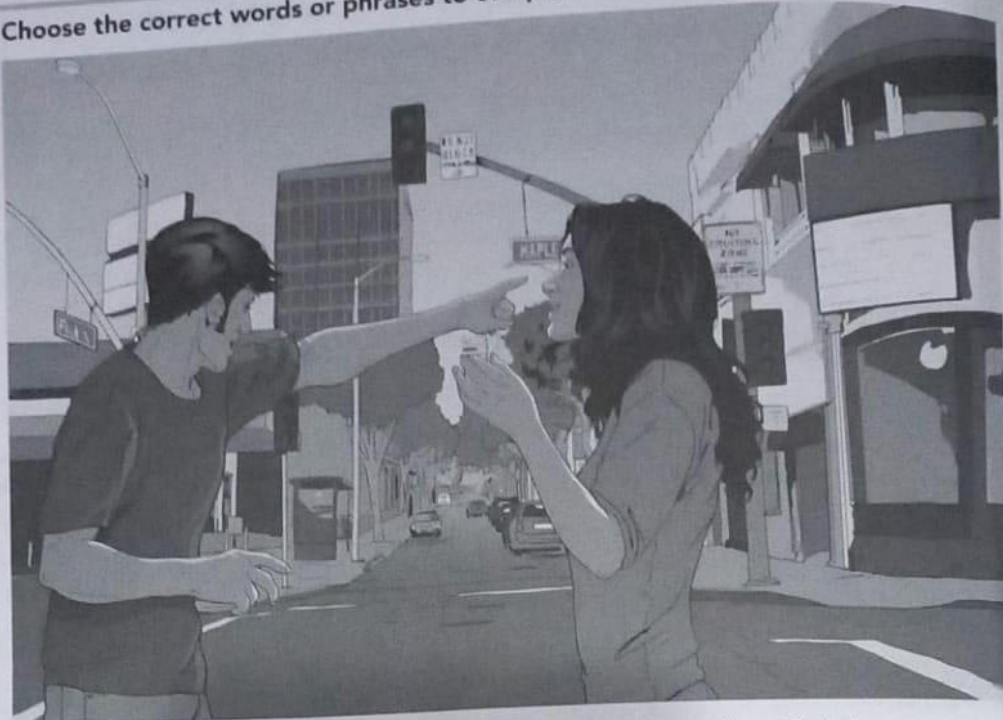
