GRAMMAR FOCUS “ Past Yes/No questions with BE ”

For Yes/No questions use the following structure: **WAS/WERE** + subject + complement.

Question	Verb to be + subject + complement Was he handsome?
Yes/No Answer	✓ Yes, He was. × No, He wasn't.



Question	Verb to be + subject + complement Were their songs successful?
Yes/No Answer	✓ Yes, they were. × No, they weren't.



GRAMMAR FOCUS “ Past Yes/No questions with BE ”

In order to ask a question in simple past tense, was/were is placed at the beginning of the sentence.

Was he in the Beatles band?

Was he from England?

Was he married?

Was he the drummer?

Was he a songwriter?

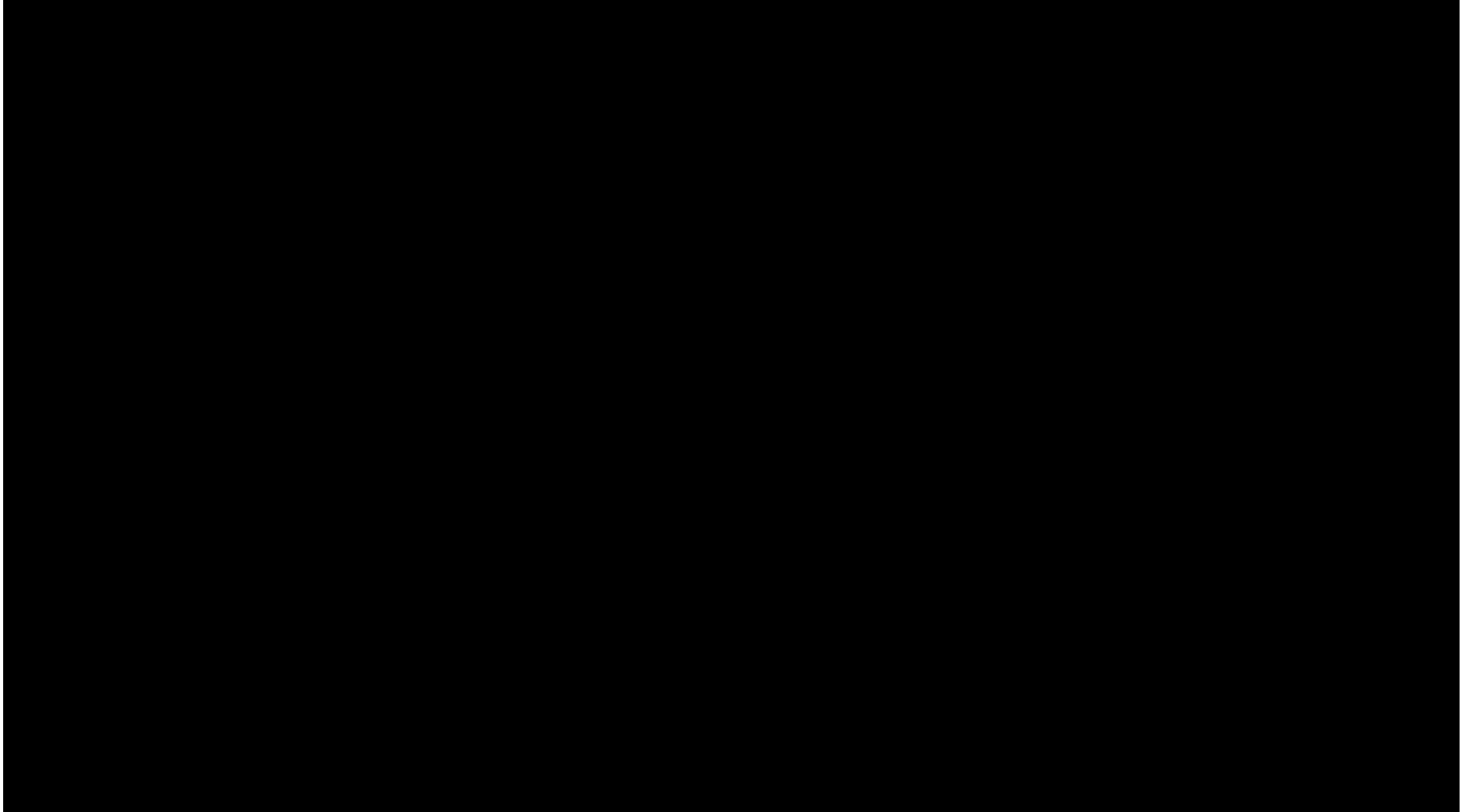
Was he ill when he died?

Was “Ia Bamba” his best song?
