GRAMMAR FOCUS "Used to for past habits"

Used to refers to something that you regularly did in the past but don't do anymore

Affirmative statements

I used to collect commic books

Subject + used to + verb + complement

Negative statements

I didn't use to collect anything

Subject + didn't use to + verb + complement

Yes/No questions

Did you use to collect things?

Did + Subject + **use** to + verb + complement

Wh questions

What did you use to collect?

WH + Did + Subject + use to + verb + complement



Used to refers to something that you regularly did in the past but don't do anymore



Yes I did, I used to play soccer





Uused to play soccer and basketball.

I never used to play sports, but now I play tennis

I didn't use to play sports, but now I play tennis



- Use the base form of *used to* in questions and negative statements: Did you **use to** play sports? (NOT: Did you used to play sports?) I didn't **use to** like bananas. (NOT: I didn't used to like bananas.)
- Don't use never in negative statements: I **never used to** wear sunglasses. (NOT: I never didn't use to wear sunglasses.)
