A PLACE TO VISIT

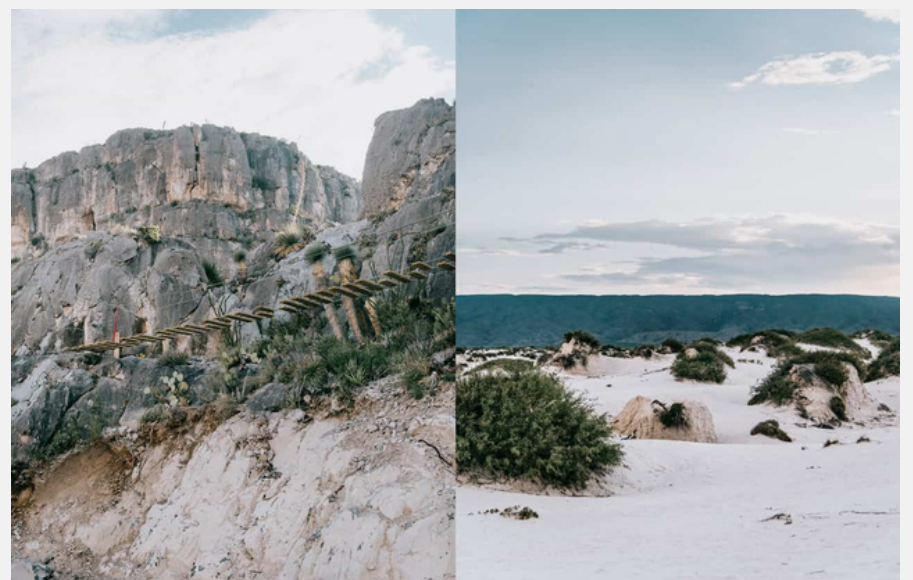
