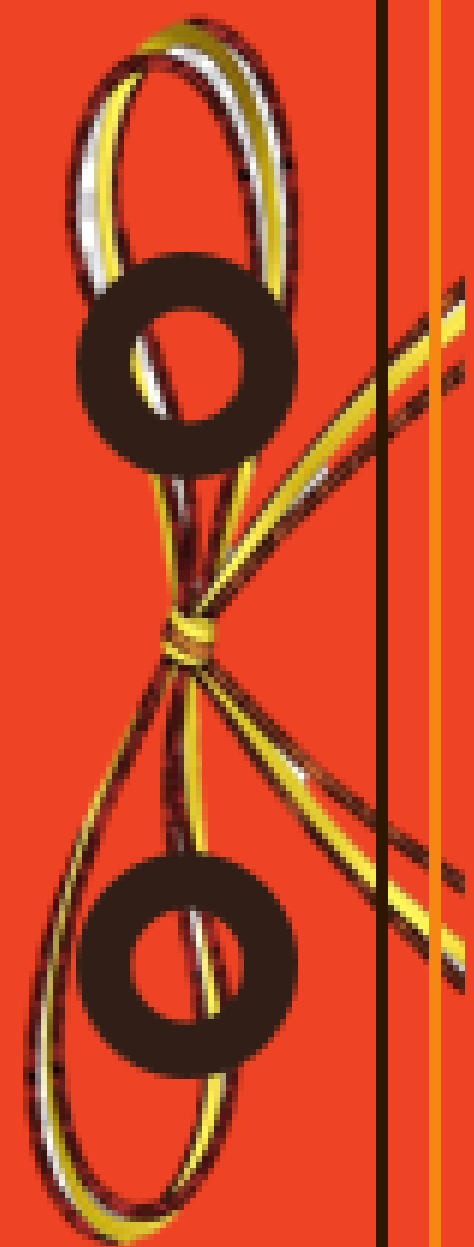

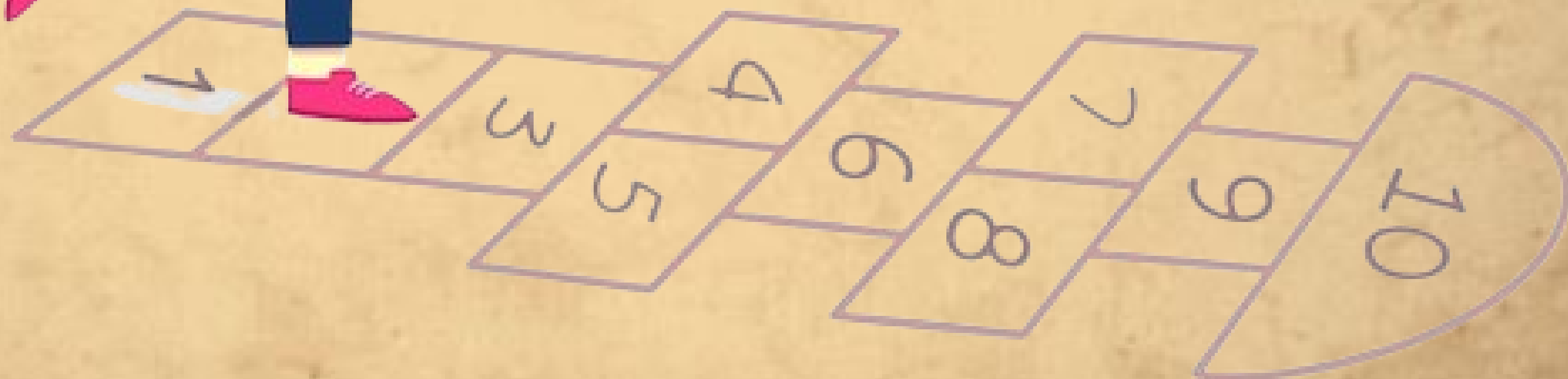

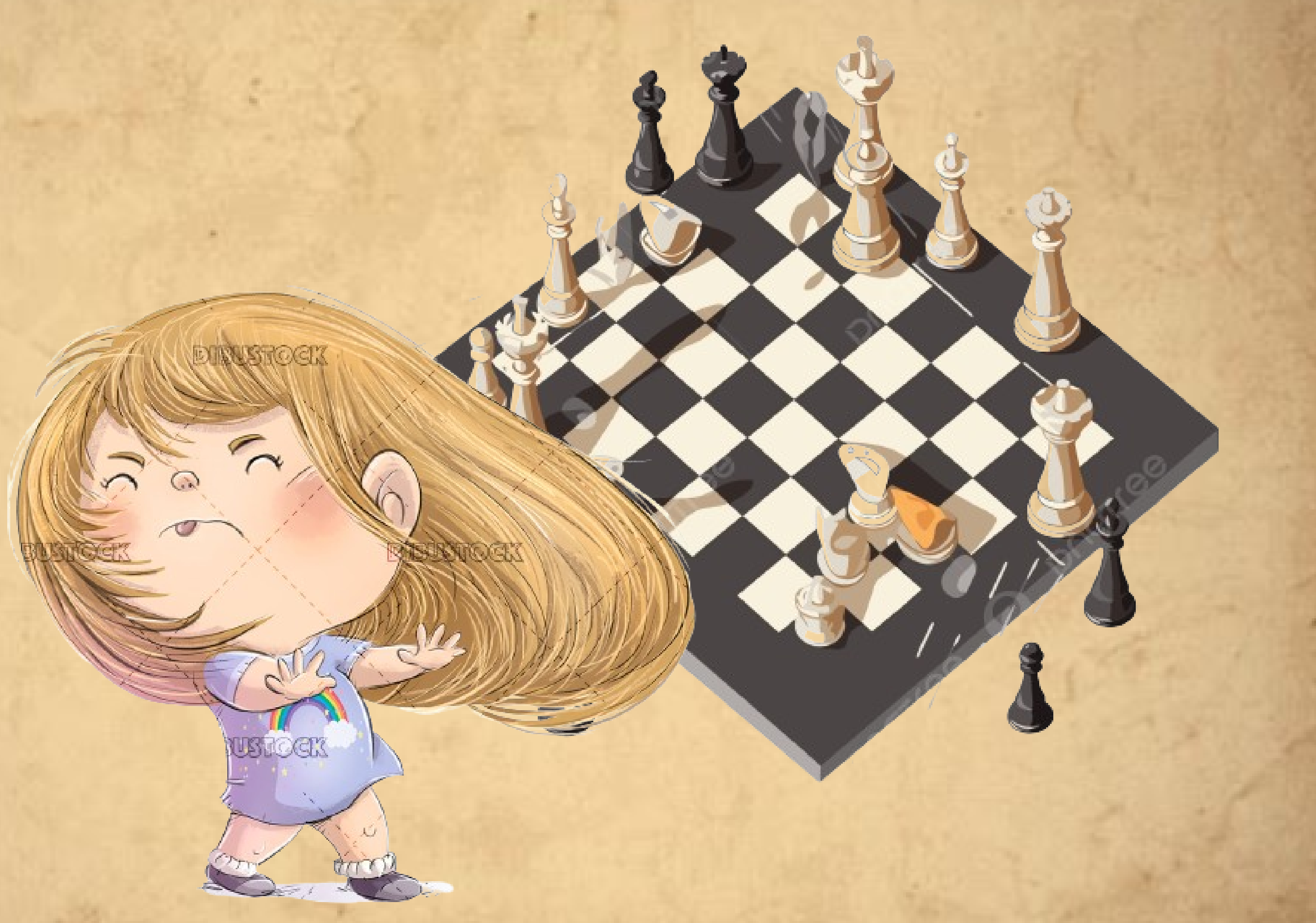




















Convesation
