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Nouns

- A word that refers to a person, place, thing, event, substance, or quality.

Compound nouns

- A compound noun is a noun that is made with two or more words.
- Example: sea + food = sea food
- Bicycle + lane = bicycle lane (a division of a road marked off with painted lines, for use by cyclists).
- Bus + station = bus station
(a terminal where buses arrive and depart)
- Recycling + center = recycling center.
(an establishment where process materials and remanufacturing them into new products)
- Train + stop = train stop (a device for automatically applying the brakes to stop a railroad train).
- Street + light = street light.
(a light illuminating a road, typically mounted on a tall pole.)

• Subway + station = subway station
(a terminal where subways load and unload passengers)

• Traffic + jam = traffic jam
(a line of road traffic at or near a standstill because of road construction, an accident, or heavy congestion)

• Taxi + stand = taxi stand.
(a place where taxicabs park while waiting to be engaged)

• I almost got run over in the bike lane

• I picked up my mom at the bus station

• The green space of the urban forest park is very nice and well kept

• I parked in the nearest parking garage lot.

• Went to the recycling center to take plastic bottles to the recycling center.

• I went to the train stop to get to know the place.

• Street light on the streets looks very nice

• My friends got lost in the subway station

• My dad got stuck in traffic jam

• went to the taxi stand in the center of town.
