

Vocabulary Life in the city

◦ **Bicycle + lane** = bicycle lane (a division of a road marked off with painted lines, for use by cyclists).

Sentence:

◦ I use the bike lane when I ride my bike to school.

◦ **Bus + station** = bus station (a terminal where buses arrive and depart)

Sentence:

◦ I'm waiting for the bus at the station.

◦ **Green + space** = green space (an area of grass, trees or other vegetation set apart for aesthetic purposes in an other urban environment).

Sentence:

◦ I go to the green space to relax.

◦ **Parking + garage** = parking garage (a building often of several stories, that provides parking space).

Sentence:

◦ A go to downtown I had to look for parking on the street.

◦ **Recycling + center** = recycling center (an establishment where process materials and remanufacture into new products).

Sentence:

◦ We leave our recyclable garbage at the recycling center.

◦ **Train + stop** = train stop (a device for automatically applying the brakes to stop a railroad train).

Sentence:

◦ I'll see you at the train stop after school.



◦ **Street + light** = Street light. (a light illuminating a road, typically mounted on a tall pole).

Sentence:

◦ Streetlights illuminate the streets at night.

◦ **Subway + station** = Subway station (a terminal where subways load and unload passengers).

Sentence:

◦ Meet me at the Subway Station for lunch.

◦ **Traffic + jam** = traffic jam (a line of road traffic at or near and standstill because of road reconstruction, an accident, or heavy congestion).

Sentence:

◦ I arrived late for work because of the traffic jam.

◦ **Taxi + stand** = taxi stand (a place where taxicabs park while waiting to be engaged).

Sentence:

◦ The taxi rank outside the headquarter is always busy.
