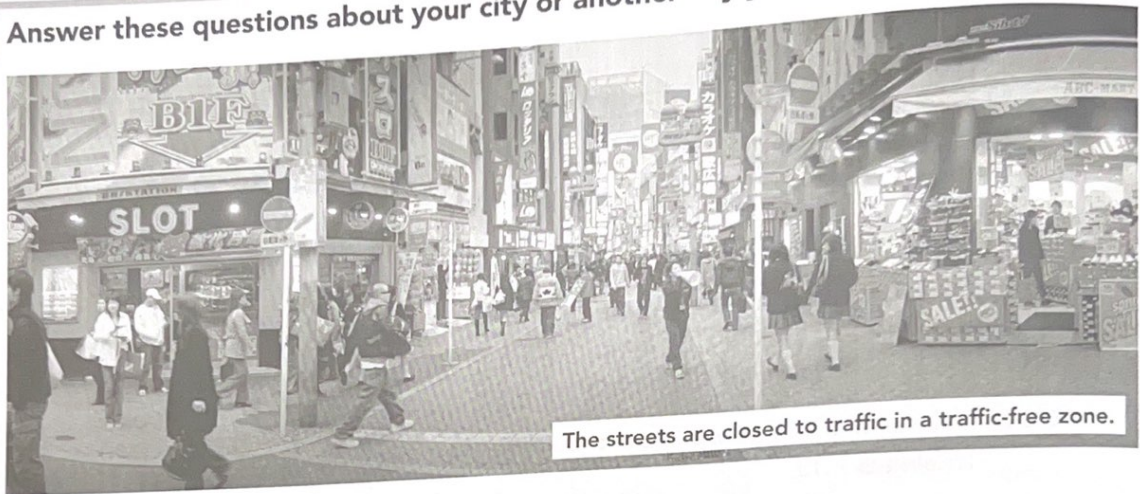


7 Rewrite these sentences. Find another way to say each sentence using the words given.
